### What Employers Expect Now


✓ Ability to use AI tools.

# The Oil Wells of Tech: Skills People Ignore but Companies Pay For

Most students rush toward coding, cybersecurity, or data analysis. Those are good. But here are the tech skills nobody pays attention to—yet they produce high-income roles.

## 1. Technical Writing

Every product needs documentation. Every SIWES report that stands out follows this skill. Companies pay well for clear thinkers.

## 2. Data Cleaning (The Dirty Side of Data)

Everybody wants to analyze data. Few want to clean it. But 70% of data work is cleaning. If you can clean data well, companies need you.

## 3. AI Prompt Operations

This is new. Companies now hire people who can operate AI tools for:

- ✓ Research
- ✓ Content Workflows
- ✓ Analysis
- ✓ Automation

This skill will explode in 2026.

## 4. Version Control (Git)

Most beginners ignore Git. But collaboration depends on it. If you understand version control early, you become valuable.

## 5. Workflow Automation (Zapier, Make, n8n)

Companies want people who turn manual tasks into automated processes. If you can automate even simple tasks, you become an asset.

## 6. Cloud Fundamentals

Not advanced cloud engineering—just basic:

- ✓ Storage
- ✓ File Access
- ✓ Simple Deployments
- ✓ Backup
- ✓ Permissions

This alone puts you in top consideration for many internship roles.
